## PBISaz 2016-2017 Objective

- 1. Assist schools in partnering with parents of students with DD on implementation of PBIS at home
- 2. Engage Early Childhood system stakeholders in offering PBIS as a strategy for infant and toddler caretakers and teachers
- 3. Increase the capacity of schools to provide intensive individual supports (Tier 3)
- 4. Increase school personnel knowledge of state and federal policy and guidance regarding use of seclusion and restraint
- 5. Improve the quality of restraint and seclusion data so that the data may inform school practices
- 6. Increase opportunities for educators to develop the knowledge and skills necessary for implementation of PBIS with fidelity
- 7. Increase the number of schools that are publicly recognized for implementing PBIS with fidelity
- 8. Increase funding in support of PBIS implementation
